C-Card

If you're aged 16-25 and live in Wakefield, you can get **FREE** condoms through Spectrum's C-Cards scheme.

How to get started

- 1 Register for a C-Card online or in person at a Spectrum Sexual Health Clinic.
- 2 Once reistered, you can collect free condoms from our community collection points.

If you're between 13-15 years old, you must contact one of our hubs to dsicuss the C-Card first.
